Pursuant to the Jan 8, 2009 memorandum *SNAP- ABAWD Statewide Waivers- New Criteria for Unemployment Insurance Extended Benefits Trigger*, please consider this Michigan's official request to extend the state's waiver to the Able Bodied Adults Without Dependents restrictions, as set forth in 7 CFR 273.24 through December 31, 2019. While Michigan is implementing Time Limited Food Assistance policy statewide, we are doing so based on recertification dates in the remaining 69 counties, as outlined in the waiver. We believe Michigan meets the eligibility for this waiver extension on the basis of the aforementioned memo, as well as its eligibility for at least second tier of Emergency Unemployment Compensation (EUC) benefits, as outlined in the June 23, 2014 trigger notice from the Department of Labor (DOL).
