The California Department of Social Services (CDSS) is requesting a two-year Able-Bodied Adults without Dependents (ABAWD) time limit waiver. If approved, the waiver will be effective November 1, 2022 through October 31, 2024, and will apply in all 58 California counties. California's current waiver is scheduled to end on June 30, 2023.

This request is part of the State's continued response to the COVID-19 pandemic emergency and is based on unemployment data from the Bureau of Labor Statistics for the 36-month period of August 2019 through July 2022.

We appreciate FNS' consideration of California's request and appreciate a prompt response so that we may issue necessary guidance. In addition, to expedite the review and decision process for CDSS' request, we are available for a conference call at your earliest convenience to discuss our request.
