Attached please find two documents. The first is the ABAWD Trigger Notice. All SERO states qualify for a continuation of the ABAWD waiver for FY 13. You only need to notify SERO that your State is adopting the waiver. An email notice is acceptable. I suggest that you also include the adoption of the FY 13 waiver in Part I, No. 2 ABAWD Population of your State Plan when submitted in August. Adoption of the waiver does not impact the state's ability to operate a mandatory program for ABAWDs or other work registrants.

The second document is the preliminary E&T allocations for FY 13. You will note some shifts in funding. The FY 13 allocation is based, primarily, on the state reported work registrants on the FNS-583 for FY 11. Please also be reminded that limited E&T carryover funds remain available for FY 12.

There have been shifts in administration in some states since the last E&T policy distribution. Therefore, if SERO needs to add or delete anyone from this distribution please let us know.
