RE: SNAP – Michigan Request to Waive Able-Bodied Adults without
Dependents Time Limit – Modification – Approval

Dear Ms. Hundley:

This is in response to the Michigan State agency's request to modify the implementation period of its waiver of the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) time limit for able-bodied adults without dependents. The State agency had previously requested to waive the time limit in 79 counties for a 6-month period, from January 1, 2017, through June 30, 2017, even though the data provided would have supported a 12-month approval period. The Food and Nutrition Service (FNS) approved that request on August 30, 2016.

On January 12, 2017, Michigan submitted an amended request to implement the waiver in the same 79 counties for the full 12-month period supported by the data initially provided by the State. FNS is approving Michigan's request to implement its waiver for the full 12-month period, from January 1, 2017 through December 31, 2017. This approval modifies the duration of waiver number 2150032, and applies to the same 79 areas under the same conditions included FNS's August 30, 2016 approval.
